The Hatteras Advantage

It's no accident that Hatteras enjoys an industry-leading reputation for quality, value and service. Every GT hull is designed to deliver a fast, comfortable ride and excellent handling in real-world sea conditions. Hatteras pioneered the combination of a convex bow shape and variable deadrise bottom in convertible hull design that makes this possible. This proven design is elevated to an art form in the GT Series. And our leading-edge propulsion systems use the industry's deepest tunnels to reduce draft and shaft angle, thus improving the vessel's efficiency. Each GT model is designed to provide best-in-class performance while maintaining the same legendary ride and durability that built the Hatteras brand.



Solid as a Rock. The brisk pace is in part due to the way we slashed weight from the hull with our proven resin-infusion process. A network of interlocking resin-infused composite bulkheads and stringers support the solid fiberglass bottom and serve as the foundation for each GT model. The decks, superstructure, and hull sides above the waterline are cored with high-density

Divinycell nonabsorbent foam, creating a stiff, durable and lightweight structure. Hatteras' superstructures are comprised of a single fiberglass part. Once complete, the superstructure is joined to the hull using self-tapping screws every three inches. The joint is then laminated internally, creating a structural bond that will stand up to the most rigorous of environments.

The Extra Mile. Extensive in-house manufacturing capabilities ensure that each component that goes into a Hatteras is built to the highest possible quality standards. This includes the new fuel tanks found in the GT Series. To simplify operation and reduce weight, we adopted a single integral fuel design tank. Because it’s mounted down the centerline, it makes for better performance since the



longitudinal center of gravity moves aft as the boat burns fuel.

And then, when any other builder would say the job is done, Hatteras goes one step further by painting the entire exterior surface of each boat. This painted finish offers

numerous advantages over gel coat: It provides a rich gloss that will last for years, returns to its original luster with a simple coat of wax, protects against water intrusion, contains a U.V. filtering agent to prevent chalking and fading, and is easier to match when repairs are required.

Hatteras Interior Luxury

Already known for our robust construction and attention to detail, Hatteras continues to push improvements in its interior fit and finish through enhanced customer interaction, improved processes, new designs and quality components.

The GT Series features a lineup of innovative interior layouts and designs that make maximum use of available space to create an environment that is both functional and comfortable. Only the highest-quality components are used throughout the interior, from the hardware and faucets to the solid-surface countertops and genuine wood panels and doors.

The cabinetry found aboard each vessel is constructed to the standards of heirloom-quality furniture, featuring dovetail drawer joints, custom mill work, and classic designs. To enhance the comfortable feeling of the boat's interior, the optional raised-panel cabinetry is constructed to appear as though each unit is a free-standing piece of furniture.

Flush-Filled Panels. Hatteras utilizes flush-filled wood panels in its interiors. These panels have numerous advantages over less sophisticated materials. All grain in the new finish is filled for a mirror-like luster, giving a clearer, more uniform gloss that presents the natural color and beauty of the wood. The hardened surface is durable, resistant to scratches, and easier to care for.

Genuine Wood Cabinetry. The Hatteras GT models feature either American cherry or mahogany available in a satin polyester finish. Raised panel cabinetry is also available as an option. And while Hatteras uses only genuine wood veneers, many competitors top their cabinetry with faux teak or reconstituted wood. Each GT interior is liberal in its use of wood in the overhead accents, wainscoting, and window framing found in the salon and design details seen throughout the boat.





Vinyl Headliners. Headliners aboard all Hatteras models are created using a tracked, removable vinyl system, enabling repairs to be made to one section of the headliner without having to replace the entire unit. These tracked panels also eliminate unsightly seam-concealing strips needed when installing traditional headliner material.

Galley & Head Design. Hatteras utilizes color-coordinated solid-surface and stone countertops with integrated sinks and bullnose edges in the galley and heads. Both feature side splashes and back splashes to contain water. The vanity head cabinets are built with stylish bowed fronts (where possible), and the cabinet bases are finished wood with flush doors. All shower doors have wood trim to protect wall coverings.
