In addition to increased onboard space, the 320 Outrage provides more comfort. The large bow area makes lounging more relaxing. Helm seating is spacious and plush, and the fold-away stern bench seat offers convenience. Several options for storage, including lockable forward rod storage and space for other carry-on items such as blankets and towels, guarantee that whatever you bring onboard won't disrupt your time on the water.

The 320's deluxe leaning post bait prep makes the aftermath of reeling in that big catch a breeze. A sink with freshwater sprayer, a pressurized livewell, an aft storage net and a prep station are just some of the features fishermen will love. For the more laid-back days on the water, the 320 boasts an incredible range of amenities. The optional summer kitchen features plenty of storage, a pull-out refrigerator/freezer, a sink with cutting board and an electric grill.

The sleek new design of the 320 looks gorgeous on the water, but boaters can also rest easy knowing it's reliable and safe. Thanks to its durable construction, the 320 is more than able to withstand the harshest weather conditions, and its exclusive hardtop/windshield system ensures incredible visibility and easily accessible console controls.

Boating Magazine put hundreds of boats to the test in order to make its widely watched top ten list. After speaking with engineers and designers, and requiring at least two editors to experience each boat firsthand, the editorial team came up with the nominations, which included runabouts, fishing boats and cruisers.
