CABO YACHTS' NEWEST SPORTFISHER demonstrates the company's intent to capture the interest of anglers looking for something a little larger than its popular 35-foot model. The 38 Flybridge is the latest high-performance boat from the Adelanto, California-based builder and illustrates Cabo's high-quality construction techniques that buyers have come to expect since 1991.

The Cabo 38 Flybridge is designed to be an excellent intermediate-sized boat with the same ride and handling characteristics of a larger vessel. Equipped with the standard twin Caterpillar C12 ACERT 715 hp diesel engines, the 38 has an expected cruise speed of 32 knots at 2000 rpm and 36 knots wide open. Buyers also have the option of other engine models, all of which offer the power and speed necessary to get to the fish in a hurry.

The hull's molded fiberglass construction uses premium vinylester resins and biaxial stitched fabric reinforcement with a solid fiberglass bottom for a sturdy ride. The standard bottom paint preparation consists of two coats of epoxy and two coats of antifouling paint in black; buyers are offered their choice of boot striping color.

Master anglers, take note: Don't let the size fool you. There's a surprising amount of storage space on board, right down to an impressive 48-gallon transom livewell, built-in tackle stations and two large-capacity macerator-equipped fishboxes, one each to port and starboard. Fresh- and saltwater washdowns are easily accessed from the cockpit, and four recessed rod racks provide extra space from which to fish. A rigging board at the bait-prep center adds to the functionality of this vessel.

The Cabo 38 Flybridge accommodates overnight anglers with a forward double berth master stateroom featuring under-berth storage, two hanging lockers, horizontal rod racks and private access to a spacious head located to starboard. Guests are welcome to a portside guest stateroom

with bunks. The open salon creates comfortable seating for relaxing or enjoying a meal prepared in the adjacent galley, which is outfitted with easy-maintenance Corian countertops, a side-by-side refrigerator/freezer, a dual-burner cooktop and microwave/convection oven. A 10 kw freshwater-cooled diesel generator keeps the electricity flowing while you're away from the docks.

With a plethora of standard and optional amenities sure to please today's angler, the Cabo 38 Flybridge offers tournament-worthy performance not seen in other vessels its size. ♡
