TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. GENERAL FISHING RULES:**
 - A fishing license is required for all participants.
 - Eligible fish are: Redfish and Flounder.
 - All fish must meet state size requirements.
 - All redfish will be measured with tail pinched.
 - There will be an 8 oz. penalty applied to any dead fished weighed in.
 - Only one of each species per boat may be weighed in.
 - All fish must be caught on rod and reel, from a boat.
 - Only one prize per specie (excluding drawings and "Tournament within a Tournament").
 - Captain's Choice format. You may fish Friday **OR** Saturday **but not both**.
 - Visual Check-Out will begin at safe light from the docks at Beach Marine. You may also check out via VHF channel 78, or by calling 904-509-2939 or 904-465-4552. You must get a live response. **NO VOICE MAILS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
 - Weigh-in opens at 2:00 and closes at 5:00 pm. You must be **IN LINE** by 5:00 pm.
- 2. TOURNAMENT WITHIN A TOURNAMENT:** There is an optional entry fee of \$50.00 per boat for a single specie or \$100.00 for a 2 specie aggregate. Captains who choose to pay the optional fee will compete for the optional entry fee purse only with other Captains who paid the optional entry fee. 85% of all entry fees go toward the purse in each division and will be divided among the top 3 Captains that paid the optional entry fee with 50% to 1st place, 30% to 2nd place, and 20 % to 3rd place in each division.
- 3. ALL BOATS** must have an operational 25 Watt VHF radio on board. Tournament headquarters will monitor VHF Channel 78 only.
- 4. TOURNAMENT WEATHER CALL** will be made at 5:00 a.m. the day of the tournament on VHF 78. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to delay, shorten or cancel the tournament due to unsafe conditions. Four hours of fishing will constitute a tournament day.
- 5. ENTRY FEES** will be returned in the event of cancellation.
- 6. WEIGHING-IN:** Bring your fish to the scale with your boat number. All fish submitted for weigh-in must be in live or fresh, edible condition, and caught the tournament day. No mutilated fish will be weighed in. Mutilation is defined as damage which impairs the fish's fighting ability. All decisions regarding mutilation will be made by the weighmaster. All boats are responsible for getting their fish to the weigh station under their own power. Fish dropped overboard during weigh-in will be disqualified.
- 7. CHECKING-IN:** All boats must check in. If you have a fish to weigh, you must check in by boat at Beach Marine. If you do not have a fish to weigh, you may check in either in person, or on VHF channel 78, or by calling 904-509-2939 or 904-465-4552 **NO LATER THAN 6:00 P.M.**
- 8. NO BOAT** may make landfall, or receive or pass anything to or from land once the tournament has begun. Likewise, no boats are to come together once the tournament has begun, unless an emergency exists.
- 9. IN CASE OF A TIE** in weight, the winner will be determined by the earliest weigh-in time.
- 10. PROTESTS** must be made within 30-minutes of the last fish being weighed for the day's competition. Any protest must be accompanied by a \$200.00 cash deposit, which will be returned if protest is upheld by the Tournament Committee. All decisions by the Tournament Committee are final.
- 11. ALL ENTRANTS** are subject to a polygraph test to receive prizes.
- 12. PARTICIPANTS enter the tournament at their own risk.** The Hook the Future Foundation, Beach Marine, Beach Marine Gone Fishin' Tournament and Marine Expo, or any of their officials, sponsors, or members shall not be liable for and hereby disclaim any liability for any and all losses, damages or injuries of any kind suffered by any participants, entrants, anglers, their guests and companions, boat captains, vessels, and equipment which may occur during the tournament, including the weigh-in location at the Beach Marine facility. Captains and their crew are responsible for following all local, state, and federal fishing and boating laws.
