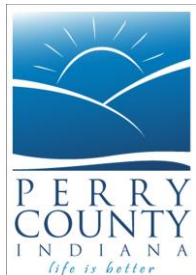

2012 Deer Creek Bass Trail Official Rules

- 1: Life vest must be worn when gas engine is running, and a lanyard type kill switch must be attached to boat operator
- 2: No trolling or use of live bait is allowed
- 3: Launch permits are required; Yearly or Daily
- 4: Fishing alone is allowed
- 5: Scoring for each event, and Team of the Year standings, is by total weight of team after any penalties or deductions
- 6: Only Largemouth, Kentucky Spotted, and Smallmouth will be counted for weigh-in
- 7: All chips must be turned in by official check-in time; teams failing to do so will be DISQUALIFIED
- 8: Six (6) fish limit per team, with a minimum length of Twelve (12) Inches measured by a Golden Rule
- 9: Fishing is permitted anywhere on the Ohio River and its tributaries, which are accessible by boat.
All fishing must be from a boat, and all contestants must remain in the boat
Boats must remain in the water during tournament hours
- 10: Short fish will NOT be weighed and teams will receive a 1 lb penalty per short fish brought to the scales
- 11: A polygraph test may be given at the discretion of the Tournament Committee
- 12: Money will be divided equally in all ties
- 13: All decisions of the Tournament Committee will be final
- 14: Dead fish: there will be no culling of dead fish, and a 1lb penalty per dead fish brought to the scales
- 15: Contestants under 18 must fish with an Adult or Legal Guardian
- 16: Fog delay: contestants will be confined to Big and Little Deer Creeks at the Tournament Director's discretion
Times and terms dictated by conditions, with announcements made prior to take-off
- 17: Check-in at Perry Marine for starting positions
Boat/Live well Check: 4 am local time at back ramp
Start: Safe Light according to Tournament Director, with weigh-in approximately 9 hr after start of tournament
Contestants may only weigh-in one time during each event
- 18: Must fish at least 4 tournaments to qualify for the classic.
- 19: Protests must be in writing, signed and in the hands of the Tournament Director within 15min. after scales are closed.
- 20: Starting position will be determined as entries are received.
- 21: No late fees will be applied. Entries will be taken at ramp until take off.
22. Pay schedule is (1 in 4)
23. Off Limits: Bridge at back ramp, to the 2nd point on the "ramp side" of Big Deer Creek, and a straight line across to the other side
Areas will be marked and noted by Tournament Staff.

By submitting this entry form we hereby agree that we have read all the 2012 Deer Creek Bass Trail rules and agree to follow said rules.

Also by submitting this form we agree that we understand participation in bass fishing contains inherent dangers, for which we accept all risk and liability. We agree to hold the Deer Creek Bass Trail, Perry Marine, Sponsors, and all agents and associates of said entities harmless from liabilities that may arise from participating in said event.
